Start the new year right by painting with your fellow artists at the Chipman Preserve. Set up your easel in wide open prairies, rolling meadows or in hushed pine forests.

Chipman is one of the largest oak savanna restoration sites on private land in the state and offers over five miles of easy to moderate trails. Red-tailed hawks, great horned owls, coyotes and numerous other wildlife make the preserve their home.

The Southwest Michigan Land Conservancy is working to restore over 200 acres of habitat. Nearby, the former house of the Chipman family is now the new offices of the South West Michigan Land Conservancy. The preserve parking area is on the north side of East Main.
