Artists to paint at beautiful Kellogg Forest

The Plein Air Artists of West Michigan once again embrace the beauty of the 716-acre Kellogg Forest, known worldwide for research on tree breeding and genetics. The Forest sits between Kalamazoo and Battle Creek, just north of Augusta.



A short distance from the parking area a wide trail leads past a large pond to a picturesque covered foot bridge which crosses over Augusta Creek. The trail then leads back to the forest and makes a wide loop around a portion of the forest taking you from the valley floor up to high hills. You can also find trails that shortcut through the forest and offer a variety of woodland landscapes to paint. It takes about an hour to walk the entire

loop. Kellogg Forest is free to enter with plenty of parking and restrooms are available.

The Paint Out begins at 11 a.m. We hope to see you there.
