900' Boardwalk offers unique scenic views

Also known as the Fred Meijer Nature Preserve, Pickerel Lake Park offers a scenic mix of natural areas to explore along a branching network of trails. The lake itself covers nearly 80 acres and is a great setting for plein air painting. One of the best-known features of the park is the 900 ft boardwalk crossing a portion of the lake. The shoreline of Pickerel Lake is undeveloped, being surrounded only by parkland and Camp Rogers to the north.



Beyond the lake shore, trails meander through unique wetlands, sandy woods, and rolling forest hills and valleys. The main restrooms are closed in the off season, but a portable restroom is available at the parking lot.

Because Pickerel Lake Park is a nature preserve, dogs are not allowed.
