Milham Park: Our Final Paint Out of 2017

Join us next Saturday, Dec. 9th • 11 a.m. at beautiful Milham Park in Kalamazoo for our final Paint Out of 2017. The park covers 49 acres with Portage Creek running through it and is crossed by two picturesque rock bridges. The creek enters the park from the southwest side, making a wide U-turn before spilling over a long low dam and exiting on the northwest side. The park has many paved pathways which criss-cross around stands of mature oaks, sycamores and pine trees. Large-rock terraced walls run the length of the creek on the south side of the park, while on the north side, it transitions from narrow to very wide due to the dam. Many moons ago, the park featured a small zoo with bears, monkeys, raccoons and exotic birds. It also had a large public swimming pool / ice skating rink and a concession stand. All of those features are only memories now, yet a couple of stone cooking grills remain.
